MHM Marine Launches New Line of Boats

Bladenboro, NC (October 15, 2011) MHM Marine announces the launch of three new models under the Savannah Boatworks line. These new models are a hybrid version of a flats and bay boat combined made of 100% composite materials. The first model of this new inshore series is the Savannah 1900 measuring 18 feet 10 inches with a beam of 7 feet 6 inches and rated for a maximum horsepower of 115. The Savannah 1900 features a snow white hull color with a webbed interior finish. Some notable features on the Savannah 1900 include one (1) 6" pull up bow cleat, 50 quart center livewell, 36 gallon under floor aluminum fuel tank, console with storage and 6 vertical rod holders and 36 quart cooler seat. This design offers plenty of fishability with the v-entry hull shape and large forward and aft casting platforms. Anglers can keep their gear in the large forward storage compartment that is apart from the anchor compartment and the two (2) aft storage boxes. This line of boats offers the everyday angler the appeal and water capabilities along with quality but at an affordable price. The 1900 will be followed by a 1700 and 2200 model.
